St Austin's War Memorial: Pte William Dolan of Marriott's Buildings, Westgate Common, was killed in action in France on 21 May 1918 having been wounded three times previously. His brother Robert was also killed in action on 13 August 1916 and his brother John was a prisoner of war in Germany. He was survived by his father, sisters and brother Edward, also in France. He was 26 years of age.

Knitting Wool: Very many thanks to all those who gave knitting wool for the refugees who use St Austin's Parish Centre as a meeting place on a weekly basis. They now have plenty to be going on with and we will let you know if they require any more.
