St Austin's Parish Centre is in regular use by parish groups and outside organisations and is run by a small group of volunteers. We have three different refugee groups who use the Centre on a weekly basis. We host a yoga class, an Irish dancing class and the Rock Choir along with the local Wine Club and the Walking Club and our own Film Clubs. The theatre is in regular use by St Austin's Players and is hired out to various theatre and dance groups. We were also a key site for the Wakefield Long Division Music Festival. This week we welcomed the Wakefield National Citizen Service which provides opportunities for 15 to 17 year olds to gain valuable experience in physical activities and new skills in communication and enterprise. All this activity provides a regular source of income, so please support these events which, financially, support your parish!
