St Austin's War Memorial: We commemorate the centenary death of Private Edward Clemson who died in a German Prisoner of War Camp on 27 July 1918 age 22. He is buried in the Cologne Southern cemetery. He was the elder brother of Robert Clemenson who was killed in action in France on 23 May 1915. Their parents were John and Martha Clemenson of Flanshaw. May they both rest in peace.
