Parish Safeguarding, DBS renewals: Following Diocesan Guidelines, all DBS checks now need to be renewed every three years. This means that there are many renewals due within the parish. Anyone whose CRB/DBS is dated prior to August 2016 is due to renew their certificate.

The Parish appreciates and relies on the volunteers who help run its activities and by renewing our safeguarding certificates we can ensure we have a safeguarding procedure that helps protect the vulnerable. To facilitate this, we propose to hold a session in St Austin's Parish rooms on Tuesday 30 July starting at 10.00 am. If your CRB/DBS is due for renewal we will contact you to arrange a time and discuss which documents you need to bring with you. If possible, you can use any three of the following: Current driving licence, passport, birth/marriage certificate, utility bill and credit card/bank/building society statement (issued in the last three months and not printed from the internet). We will have help from Leeds safeguarding personnel helping us to make the process as painless as possible. We will make alternative arrangements for those who cannot attend on this date.
