**St Austin's Choir** will be on tour in Austria next weekend. Based in Innsbruck the choir will sing outside one of the city's main attractions, The Golden Roof, on Friday afternoon. On Saturday the choir will give a recital in Salzburg Cathedral before singing Mass and giving a concert at St Michael's Church, Mondsee. 'The Sound of Music' fans will recognise the church from the film as it is where the marriage was filmed! Finally, on Sunday the choir will sing Mass and give a concert at the Church of the Jesuit College in Innsbruck.

**Pilgrimage to Rome:** We are hoping to take a parish pilgrimage to Rome from the 30th August to 6<sup>th</sup> September next year. This will include four nights in the City and a further three nights in the villa of the English College by Lake Albano opposite the Pope's summer palace. There is a full programme of excursions and activities. Full details from Joan Gossner (tel. 242610, after 10<sup>th</sup> August). The cost is £1,395 per person (sharing in Rome and a single room at the villa) with a £100 supplement for a single room throughout. The cost includes dinner, bed and breakfast daily and lunch on four days. Fr Smith will be leading the pilgrimage as spiritual director. There will be a meeting in September or October in the Parish Centre to discuss the details of the pilgrimage, what is included and what is involved. Look out for the date. The proposed itinerary is on display in the narthex.

There will be a celebratory birthday Mass in St Austin's Church on Saturday 14 September at 1.00 pm for Orlan Edwards, preceded by the presentation of songs at 12 noon. The Church will be decorated with flowers on the Friday afternoon.
