Changes of Sunday Mass Times and details of the Easter Triduum Services 2021

Following the announcement from the Prime Minister outlining details of the "roadmap" out of the pandemic, it is timely that we take advantage of the beginning of the relaxation of rules.

From Easter Sunday Masses at St Austin will be at 8 am, 9 30 am, 11 am and 6 pm. There will be a 9 30 am Sunday Mass at the church of the English Martyrs which will replace the 12 noon Mass on Saturdays.

The Mass at St Austin for the Easter Vigil will be at 8 pm and subsequently the Vigil Mass will be celebrated at 6 15 pm as usual.

We can take this as a sign that things are improving and I hope these changes may encourage more of our congregation to attend Mass. Once the relaxation of rules is complete we will return to our usual Mass schedule which we used before the pandemic. **Mgr Smith**

There will be services at 3 pm and 5 30 pm on **Good Friday**. As with all Masses places will have to be booked online (preferably). Alternatively there are a limited number of places available by telephone.

Bookings for Good Friday opens on Sunday 14th March at 7 30 pm

Please note that the **Good Friday** services booking system is separate to the normal one. The links can also be found by clicking on the 'Book a place at Mass' box.

Places can also be booked for the Mass on **Holy Thursday (7 pm)** and the **Easter Vigil (8 pm)**.

The new Sunday schedule starts on **Easter Sunday** [details given above] and places at those Masses need to be booked in the usual online way.
