# Parish Priest: Mgr David Canon Smith



Mgr David Canon Smith was born in Goole and became our Parish Priest in February 2016. He was previously at St Mary's in Halifax where he was Parish Priest for 16 years. Before that he was Parish Priest in Knottingley and curate in Halifax and Brighouse. He trained for the priesthood at Valladolid in Spain and was ordained a priest in 1987.

# **Assistant Priest:** Fr Sean Crawley



Fr Sean Crawley was born in Leeds. He joined us from the Parish of St John Mary Vianney in North Leeds, in September 2017, where he had been Curate for two years. He trained for 7 years for the priesthood at the Venerable English College in Rome and before that at the Royal English College in Valladolid, and was ordained to the sacred priesthood on 25 July 2015.

# **Becoming a Catholic Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)**
