

LITTLE BITS OF GOD' MOSAIC: During the Year of the Word in 2020 a mosaic was commissioned as part of the God Who Speaks initiative entitled, 'Little Bits of God'. The mosaic is coming to Leeds Cathedral from Saturday 14th January until Thursday 9th February 2023. The mosaic will be housed in the north transept and will be accessible to be visited when the Cathedral is open outside of liturgy times. There will be resources available to explain the mosaic. The mosaic will be launched at the 12noon Mass on Saturday 14th January 2023 followed by a talk about the mosaic. The Vicariate for Education will be co-ordinating visits from both Primary and Secondary Schools. There will be some dates (yet to be confirmed) when there will be people on hand to give a 'tour' of the mosaic.
