

Traditional Latin Mass (Extraordinary Rite) will be celebrated in the Chantry Chapel, Wakefield, next Friday 7 July at 7.00 pm. Monsignor Smith will be the celebrant, and the Mass will be sung by St Austin's Choir. The Mass will be to commemorate the death of William Byrd who died 4 July 1623. William Byrd was the foremost composer of his day and a recusant Catholic. His talent probably saved him and his family from imprisonment and worse. Much of his later music reflected his plea for Catholics to be allowed more freedom to worship in the late Elizabethan/Stuart times.

Eucharistic Service. Because many of the people normally involved will be in Lourdes, there will be no Service of Word and Holy Communion (Eucharistic Service) at English Martyrs on Wednesday 12 July.
