The Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme has been essential to funding the repairs and improvements of listed churches for many years and St Austin's is, of course, a listed building. The Scheme allows for the recovery of VAT on these important projects. The Scheme is reviewed annually as part of the Government's Budget process and is to be reviewed in March 2025. If the Scheme is not renewed, this will have a considerable financial impact on the viability of any listed church projects - and we of course are planning repairs and renovations to mark the Bicentennial of St Austin's in 2028. It is vital that we communicate to the Government the importance of this Scheme. The Bishops' Conference Patrimony Committee have set up an e-campaign so that people can easily send a (pre-written) letter to their local MPs in support of continuing the Scheme. There is very little time to mobilise this before the Budget on 30 October 2024. We are asking as many parishioners as possible to send letters to their MP.
