Easter Break: Some of our groups are taking a break for Easter. All will return w/c 21st April.

**Ecumenical Events:** Stations of the Cross will take place at English Martyrs church on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> April at 7pm. This is with worshippers from St George's church in Lupset and St James' in Thornes. Refreshments will be served afterwards in the hall. There will then be services at St James' on Tuesday and at St George's on Wednesday both at 7pm, again with refreshments afterwards. The annual Ecumenical Walk of Witness will take place on Good Friday April 18th, meeting outside the West Door of Wakefield Cathedral at 9.30am and concluding with a short Service at about 10.30.

Please be aware that only one Mass intention can typically be offered at each Mass, so if a date/time is already taken, the intention will have to be offered on alternative day. There is no limit to how early intentions are submitted so don't delay!

**Chrism Mass:** The annual Chrism Mass will take place on Wednesday of Holy Week (16 April) at Leeds Cathedral at 11:00am. The sacred oils of Chrism, Catechumens and the Sick, used throughout the Diocese, will be blessed at the annual celebration. Our priests will also renew their priestly promises. All welcome to attend.

Assisted Suicide Bill: The Committee Stage has now ended. The Bill is now weaker and less safe than it was before. 300+ amendments that sought to strengthen safeguards in the Bill and protect vulnerable groups were rejected by Bill supporters, including protection for people with disabilities and domestic abuse victims. The next reading of the Bill is Friday 25 April. Please take action - collect a postcard from the back of church and post it to your MP today!
