HOLY YEAR. As you know this year has been designated a Jubilee or Holy Year. In our deanery there will be special Jubilee Masses in each of the parishes. Parishioners are encouraged to go to some or all of these Masses and so become 'pilgrims' in this Holy Year whose theme is Pilgrims of Hope. The first of these Jubilee Masses will be on Easter Thursday (24 April) at 7.00pm at St Joseph's in Castleford. Other Jubilee Masses are: Tuesday 27 May - St Austin's Wakefield; Tuesday 17 June - Sacred Heart Hemsworth; Tuesday 15 July - St John's Normanton; Tuesday 9 September - St Michael's Knottingley. All Jubilee Masses start at 7.00pm

Restoration Project: Thanks also to those who donate, whether large or small to the restoration project but prefer to remain anonymous. Every little helps! We have started to pull together reports on restoring and refurbishing the church in time for our bi-centenary in 2028. More details will be shared in due course but the costs are likely to be several hundred thousand pounds! Donations are vital!

Mass Intentions: A polite reminder to ensure you send in any Mass intentions in plenty of time. Typically we need at least 2 weeks notice to try and ensure Mass for your intention is said on the day you ask. Please be aware that only one Mass intention can typically be offered at each Mass, so if a date/time is already taken, the intention will have to be offered on alternative day. There is no limit to how early intentions are submitted so don't delay!

Altar Servers: The cottas worn by our altar servers have been freshly washed and ironed in time for Easter. Can all parents of our servers please remind their sons and daughters that these should be hung on a hanger after each Mass, so we keep them looking their best for as long as possible.

Assisted Suicide Bill: The Committee Stage has now ended. The Bill is now weaker and less safe than it was before. 300+ amendments that sought to strengthen safeguards in the Bill and protect vulnerable groups were rejected by Bill supporters, including protection for people with disabilities and domestic abuse victims. The next reading of the Bill is Friday 25 April. Please take action - collect a postcard from the back of church and post it to your MP today!
